

 A \$20.00 deposit will hold your spot.**

The \$125.00 fee for the class includes, ammunition, target, ear protection, a copy of the latest Texas LTC law book to keep, range fees, and notary fees. A \$20.00 deposit will reserve a seat.

You will need to pay your state fee which will be \$40.00 for four years. The state does offer some discounts such as: \$25.00 for peace officers or honorably discharged veterans (must have a copy of your DD-214) and no fee for active military (or within a year of an honorable discharge). You will also need to get electronic fingerprints for \$10.00. The state application and fingerprint scheduling can be done online* at www.txdps.state.tx.us.

You are responsible for bringing a handgun. If you need to rent a handgun, you must notify us prior to the day of the class. We rent them for \$10.00.

We will have every form you will need for the class. We go over everything in class to try to prevent any delays in the processing of your application by the state.

Please park behind the store and bring your firearm into the classroom
UNLOADED.

*Online LTC registration help for new applications is available at the store for \$25.00 or \$15.00 for renewals.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED FOR THE LTC CLASS

- A handgun (unless you are renting, then we will supply one). Please make sure your gun is lubricated and working properly.
- If possible, two or more (or ten) magazines for your gun (if renting, we will supply the magazines).
- A baseball or other brim-style hat.
- A shirt with a button-up collar or a t-shirt.
- No sandals.
- Hearing protection (disposable ear plugs will be supplied at the range).
- Eye protection (glasses count).
- Relax...it's self-defense shooting, not sniper school. 😊
